We will learn a variety of songs from the jazz canon ranging from early jazz through contemporary styles. We will learn and rehearse the rhythms, techniques, orchestrations, and songs of each respective style with performances on, and possibly off, campus.

Grading

Grading will be based solely on attendance and preparedness. If an excess of absences occur without prior notification grades will be adjusted accordingly. All participants are expected to learn and prepare the music and material assigned in a timely and professional manner.

Absence Policy

ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED. As per the student handbook: When a student has accumulated unofficial absences in excess of the number of times the class meets per week, the instructor may, but is not required to, file a withdrawal from class. Each additional absence will affect your final grade as outlined below. Official absences (SCC Field trips, SCC tournaments, jury duty, etc.) and observance of religious holidays will not be counted as absences.
